This coffee came across our cupping table, and we fell in love with its kiwi-like acidity and notes of florals and peach, grounded by honeyed sweetness. We owe the opportunity to work with this coffee to our partner Bertie Sewell at Covoya and his unique history with the Insani cooperative. Before Insani AMCOS (Agricultural Marketing Co-operative Society) built their own washing station in 2016, Bertie worked in East Africa for the exporter that pre-financed these farmers and processed their cherries. After moving to the import side here in the UK, he continues to advocate the incredible profiles coming out of the broader Mbeya region. Insani will have you reaching for your flavour wheel to describe its combination of florals, dried fruits, and tropical fruits.
