Founded by 20 local farmers in 2007, our introduction to the Cocatu produce group came through our partners DR Wakefield and the Kinini Coffee's Washing Station in Tumba. Difficulties caused by the global financial crisis led the now 260-member-strong Cocatu group to start their work with the Kinini Washing Station in 2017. Leaning on Kinini for its processing efficiency and reputable quality control, the farmers also gain access to training and financial advice, encouraging saving when they get paid. Some farmers also use those savings to lend to other farmers and earn profits, a system they call "Cocatu Microfinance". A bright, sunny cup, Cocatu makes the perfect light, silky-bodied, juice-bomb afternoon brew to ease you into 2024.
