RAISIN / ALMOND / CAMEL



A full subscriber exclusive, welcome your newest comfort coffee, Los Huipiles! This easy-drinking delight from the Huehuetenango department (also known as “HueHue,” pronounced WAY-way) will be a friendly addition to any routine. This multi-producer blend gets its name from the huipiles (wee-PILL-es) worn by women in Northern Guatemala and Southern Mexico. The emblematic Mayan garment is a fitting representation for “HueHue,” known for its diversity of Mayan groups such as Mam, Chuj, and Jakaltek. The same jagged mountains that allowed for the development of these distinct cultural groups create variety in flavour profile among the coffees grown there. Farmers that contribute to this blend come from a cross-section of cultures and farm styles, woven together in this blend constructed by exporter Volcafe’s buying station in the region. The resulting combination is clean and simple with notes of almond and caramel.
