Flavour notes

BLACK GRAPE / CHERRY / TOFFEE



Specially chosen just for filter subscribers, Kinini is a juice bomb of a brew with its black grape, cherry and chewy toffee sweetness. Produced in the region of Rulindo, Rwanda, this coffee stems from the same washing station as Cocatu, a recent offering in our shop. This natural lot however represents the efforts of the washing station itself, as those involved execute the arduous natural process after buying the cherries themselves. The cherries are de-pulped on a 4-disc McKinnon pulper and there are a number of tanks for fermentation, leading to channels for the soaking tanks, followed by the drying beds. Ensuring traceability to the micro-lots, each raised bed comes with its own marker and tarpaulin for quick covering during any rainfall. To guarantee the coffee is even more up to standard, satellite technology is used to monitor leaf glare from the trees as any change can be a sign of disease or infestation. Continuously developing their facility, they even have plans to create a space to welcome and host visitors in the future!
