Introducing Karora, the latest addition to our Rwanda selection! This juice bomb is a bright and sunny treat from sisters Francine Nyiramana and Immaculée Mukamana and the contributing farmers of Karora Washing Station. After inheriting their family farm, Nyamurinda Hills, located in the Nyamagabe District and turning it into a coffee plantation they expanded their activities to operating the Karora Washing Station in the Western District, where they process coffee cherries from nearby farmers.

With 1,022 registered smallholder farmers, mostly women, organised under the Karora cooperative, this project shines a spotlight on Rwanda becoming a hub for women-led farming initiatives with orphans and widows of the genocide starting businesses, farms, etc. and experiencing a level of independence and agency not commonly associated with East Africa.

The perfect weekend cup, Karora, is fruity and floral, featuring notes of apricot, orange, and red berries.
