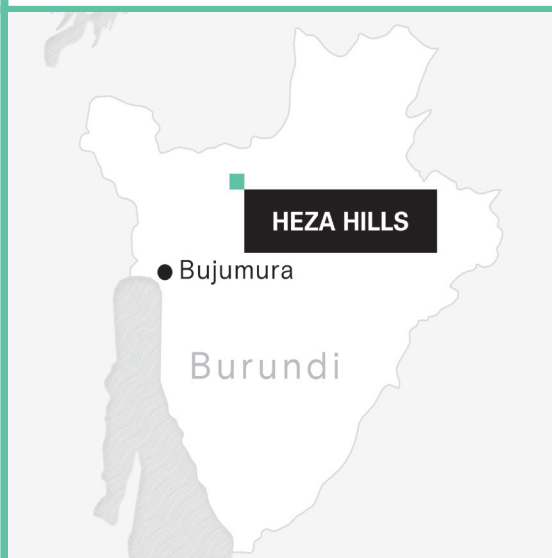

An exciting step forward: usually available in single-hill lots, by building this 5-hill lot, our partners, Long Miles Coffee, have expanded their buying footprint in the area, reaching more farmers. Describing Heza Washing Station as 'remote' is an understatement. The community surrounding it is unique, primarily made up of coffee farmers. In Kirundi, the local language of Burundi, Heza means 'beautiful place,' and this washing station certainly lives up to its name, offering panoramic views and a constantly changing East African sky.
