DRIED APPLE / HAZELNUT / COCOA

With cosy notes of dried fruit and a creamy texture, welcome Taypiplaya from Caranavi, Bolivia!

This easy drinker marks our second year in a row purchasing from exporter Agricafe's Sol de La Mañana program. This initiative exemplifies the "hub-and-spoke" model, where a recognized farm trains and processes coffee from neighbouring farms. However, Sol De La Mañana is one of the most robust programs of its kind: Agricafe provides all agricultural inputs (fertilizer, tools) at cost, offers a hands-on agronomy and processing curriculum, and prioritises cash payments and quality premiums.

Agricafe, led by the Rodriguez family, began this incredible investment in Bolivian coffee culture in 2014 and now works around a hundred producers across the four colonías (towns). Growers in the colonia of Taypiplaya joined the program in 2018, and thirty individuals contributed to this comforting, classic brew.
